What stood out, challenged, or confused you about this week's message?

Read 1 Samuel 21 and Psalm 34. How does David's story in 1 Samuel influence how you read Psalm 34?

What are some ways we end up worshipping our own personal wants and desires over God? What are some of the dangers of self-worship?

What are some ways to "taste and see" that the Lord is good?

Why does repentance follow seeing that God is good?

How does God provide hope for you?

PRAY

Close with a time of prayer for your faith journey and the journeys of people in your family, small group, or friend circles. Consider writing down prayer requests. Pray specifically for areas where God is calling you, or your family or group, to be obedient to Jesus and for opportunities to share your freedom in Christ with others. Pray for strength to be the church, to be urgent about the kingdom, and to follow Jesus without hesitation. Pray for more awareness of spiritual warfare and the ability to fight against it from a place of victory, not fear. Pray for God to reveal next steps for His Kingdom and how to live in a way that pleases God!
