READ: Philippians 1:1-11 Step 4: List some key words:

Step 1: underline nouns

<u>Step 2</u>: double underline verbs <u>Step 3</u>: circle descriptive words

Snapshot: Philippians is a letter written by the Apostle Paul around A.D. 53-59. Paul is writing to Christians in Philippi about spiritual growth and having joy in the face of suffering.

- How does Paul's view of circumstances differ from ours?
- How can we care for each other the way Paul cared for the Philippians?

Philippians 1:9-11

- How does love lead to more knowledge and discernment?
- How good are we at "discerning what is best?" What can we do to get better?
- What does it look like to be "filled with the fruit of righteousness?"
